The UNL Procurement Team would like to share information with end users about the recent HP division into two independent publicly traded companies.

- Hewlett Packard Enterprise

The legal separation was completed on November 1st and will go into effect on our campus immediately. HP decided to make the change after several years of reviewing their position of strength, confidence, and speed of market transitions. HP believes customers will benefit from having two separate companies. Examples of improvements include:

- Each company will be fully focused on its particular markets and meeting your specific needs.
- The new structure will enhance direct executive accountability for the product road map.
- The separation enhances each company's ability to invest in key capabilities and innovation.

No, HP has confirmed that they will honor warranty and support contracts.
